Terms of Reference

Learning Resources and Property

- 1. Develop and monitor the School's strategy for learning resources including the inclusivity of facilities, the safe and effective use of facilities, and the use of digital and virtual environments;
- 2. Develop and monitor the School's strategy for administrative support systems which enable LIS to monitor student progression and performance accurately and provide timely accurate information for academic and non-academic management information needs;
- 3. Provide an initial forum for self-critical scrutiny, especially by the academic faculty, of decisions relating to Learning Resources and Property;
- 4. Ensure that the environment for learning which has been promised to students through promotional materials and/or in internal handbooks is being delivered to the standards promised;
- 5. Ensure that students are able to contribute to oversight of the learning and teaching infrastructure;
- 6. Provide a summary of developments for the Academic Council and Board, and external stakeholders including students if required.

Data and IT

- 1. Oversee governance of Data and Digital strategy.
- 2. Oversee data strategy including support of DPO.
- 3. Advise on changes and improvements to LIS Data, Digital and IT infrastructure and systems including through the assessment of student and staff feedback
- 4. Provide oversight of regulations linked to data and digital services including relevant risks (e.g. cybersecurity) and milestones in DAPs Plan
- 5. Propose changes to relevant LIS Data, digital and IT policies

The LRPDIT Committee will report to the Academic Council as requested and at least on an annual basis.
